- *Vocabulary:* House and home. Daily life.

### **Unit 2: STUDENT DAYS**

- *Grammar:* Past Simple/Past Continuous. Used to. (Ir)regular Verbs past tense forms. Verb+ noun combinations.

### **UNIT 3: FUN TIME**

- *Grammar:* Verbs followed by to or -ing. Negative Prefixes. Phrasal verbs.
- *Vocabulary:* Hobbies and leisure. Free time.

### **Unit 4: OUR WORLD**

- *Grammar:* Comparative and superlative adjectives,(not)as ... as ... Gradable and non-gradable adjectives. Modifiers
- *Vocabulary:* Holiday activities. Travel, journey or trip? Buildings and places. Adjectives used to describe places.

### **Unit 5: FEELINGS**

- *Grammar:* Modal verbs: ability and possibility, advice, obligation and prohibition.
- *Vocabulary:* Adjectives with-ed and -ing. Adjectives and prepositions. Adjectives of emotion and their opposites.

## **Unit 6: LEISURE AND FASHION.**

- *Grammar:* Present Perfect: already, just, yet, for, since. Present Perfect vs. Past Simple.
- *Vocabulary:* Television programmes. Going out. Been/gone, meet, get to know, know and find out. Describing clothes.

- *Grammar:* Future: will, going to, present continuous. Present Simple.
- *Vocabulary:*, Adverbs of degree, too and enough. Prepositions of movement. On foot, by car, etc. Compound Nouns

## **Unit 8: THIS IS ME!**

- *Grammar:* Zero, first and second conditionals. When, if, Unless + present, future. So do I and nor/neither do I.
- *Vocabulary:* Describing people. Phrasal Verbs. Prefixes and Suffixes.

- *Grammar:* Defining and nondefining relative clauses. Past Perfect Simple.

- *Vocabulary:* Noun suffixes.
